Ken Bailey Video Class August 7 and 12

Dr. Bailey continues his discussion with more dramatic actions of Jesus as He interpreted the need to endure the cross. These actions include His arrest in the Garden of Gethsemane, His appearance to the Disciples in the locked room following His resurrection, and His purpose in telling the parable of the Good Samaritan. In each example, Jesus was demonstrating the love He had for them and the extent to which He was willing to suffer for them.

Identical one-hour sessions will be held in Founders' Hall on Wednesday the 7th at 7:00pm and Monday the 12th at 2:00pm. Each begins with a 30 minute video followed by a discussion of Dr. Bailey's insights. Everyone is invited to attend one of these classes.
