
We want to make a special request of our families:

Ken Bailey Video Class — December 3 and 9

Dr. Ken Bailey concludes his presentation of "Jesus Interprets His Own Cross" by discussing the ways that the Gospel writers have summarized the events surrounding the cross. Bailey cites The Suffering Servant of Isaiah 53 and how it relates to the conversations in the Upper Room. While the accounts of Mark and Matthew are identical in both the events and their sequence, Luke records different events and in a different order. Dr. Bailey also discusses the scene and the persons at the cross. He then gives a summary of the entire 13-session series in which our understanding of the cross starts with Jesus' teachings and is focused for us in the Upper Room. There we learn of the inner heart of God who is willing to suffer in and through His Son. As the Apostle Paul says, "The cross is the power and wisdom of God." Identical one-hour sessions will be held in Founders' Hall on Tuesday (this month) the 3rd at 7pm and Monday the 9th at 2pm.
