## Planning Ahead

### **Ken Bailey Video Class — September 4 and 9**

Dr. Bailey moves his discussion of "Jesus Interprets His Own Cross" from His dramatic actions and into His teachings. The first example, the parable of The Great Banquet, gives us a vision that God cares for all people and calls them to respond to who He is. The parable tells of three people who offer excuses for not attending the banquet. These excuses insult and anger God the host. But God takes that anger and turns it into grace. A second parable, The Lost Sheep, gives us a picture of Jesus who exerts great energy to seek the lost sheep and bring it back to the fold, carrying it on His shoulders and rejoicing. Jesus, our Lord, is the good shepherd who pays the price that we might be restored. Identical one-hour sessions will be held in Founders' Hall on Wednesday the 4th at 7pm and Monday the 9th at 2pm. You are warmly invited to attend one of these classes.
