


Birthday Sunday Celebrations

Planning Ahead

Ken Bailey Video Series — August 6th and 11th

The Dr. Kenneth Bailey video series "Women in the New Testament" concludes this month with "Human Sexuality" and "Christian Marriage." Dr. Bailey analyzes the apostle Paul's statement that the resurrection is at the heart of human sexuality and that our spiritual body, when resurrected, is recognizable to earthly friends who also have been resurrected. In Ephesians 5, Paul says that in a Christian marriage the wife freely chooses to grant a leadership role to the husband just as the church allows Christ to lead it. The husband is to lead the marriage as Christ leads the Church. The husband becomes a servant. This leads to a new freedom for both. Identical one-hour sessions will be held on Wednesday the 6th at 7pm and on Monday the 11th at 2pm in Founders' Hall. The 30-minute DVD is followed by an informal discussion of Dr. Bailey's presentation. Everyone is most welcome.
