Sunday School Schedule



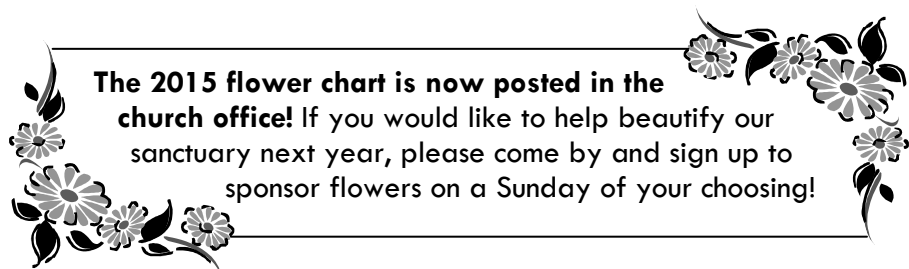
