Ken Bailey Video Series—December 8th

This month Dr. Kenneth Bailey concludes his series on “The Lord’s Prayer” by discussing forgiveness of debts and trespasses as well as temptation and delivery from evil. Jesus speaks of how we need to give and receive forgiveness every day. Forgiving does not mean “never mind,” but rather it comes out of our struggle for justice versus vengeance. Jesus concludes this great prayer with a petition to “not let us fall into or go in the direction of temptation” even though our tendency is to go that way. This awesome prayer can be called a summary of the theology of God, a very dense condensation of an incredibly long list of some of the weightiest themes of the theology of our Lord. A one-hour session will be held on **Mon. 12/8 at 2pm** in Founders' Hall. Newcomers are always welcome.
