### Ken Bailey Video Class — February 5 and 10

Dr. Ken Bailey concludes his presentation of "Understanding the Bible" by discussing "The Seven Sins of Bible Interpretation." These are the methods that various people have used over the centuries to interpret the Scriptures. They include the "allegorical method," the "cut and paste method," and the "colored glasses method." These and other "sins of Bible interpretation" remind us to try to discover what the original author intends for his readers. We will be rewarded with new understanding when we put ourselves in the original audience and the original cultural context. Identical one-hour sessions will be held in Founders' Hall on Wednesday the 5th at 7:00 p.m. and Monday the 10th at 2:00 p.m. Each begins with a 30-minute video followed by a discussion of Dr. Bailey's insights. First-timers are especially invited to come and enjoy the insights that Ken Bailey offers.
