Ken Bailey Video Series July 2nd and 14th

The "Women in the New Testament" video series continues this month as Dr. Kenneth Bailey gives his insights into the place of women in the Greco-Roman world and how the Apostle Paul's letters dealt with those traditions. Also, 1 Corinthians 14 tells women to be silent in church and 1 Timothy 2 has been understood to deny women any authority over men. Bailey shows how these two texts can be harmonized with the practice of the early church where many leading women were disciples, teachers, deacons, prophets, and apostles. Identical one-hour sessions will be held on Wednesday the 2nd at 7:00 p.m. and on Monday the 14th at 2:00 p.m. in Founders' Hall.
