Ken Bailey Video Series — March 4th and 10th

This month we start a new six-part video series titled "Women in the New Testament." In this first session, Dr. Bailey notes that the literature of the Middle East falls into two opposing camps, each quoting certain literature and scripture while quietly ignoring others. Is the New Testament inconsistent? The Bible uses both male and female images to enrich our understanding of God. Even "wisdom," a particular attribute of God, is described in female terms.

Identical one-hour sessions will be held on Tuesday (this month) the 4th at 7pm and Monday the 10th at 2pm in Founders' Hall. The 30-minute DVD is followed by a discussion of our reactions to Dr. Bailey's presentation. Everyone is most welcome, including first-timers.
