Race and Reconciliation Workshop at PB Presbyterian Church **9:00 AM to 5:00 PM; Saturday, June 07, 2014**

Dr. Henry Payne who professionally facilitates the workshop, is a human resources and organizational development consultant with many years of experience. Ken Bailey Video Series — June 4th and 9th

The "Women in the New Testament" video series continues this month with "Women Prophets" in which Dr. Kenneth Bailey points out the many examples of outstanding women in the New Testament community at the time of Christ. Among them were women who were given the gifts of prophecy equal to those of men.

Jesus Himself consistently told His parables in pairs, one which men could easily understand and another for women. Bailey shows that women are prominent in the genealogy of Jesus. They are messengers to the Apostles on Easter morning, disciples, and supporters of Jesus' ministry. He also points out that woman was created from man's side as an equal, not from his head as a superior or from his foot as an inferior.

Identical one-hour sessions will be held on Wed. 6/4 at 7pm and on Mon. 6/9 at 2pm in Founders' Hall. The 30-minute DVD is followed by a discussion of Dr. Bailey's presentation.
