Ken Bailey Video Series — October 13th

This month is the second in this video series on The Lord's Prayer from a Middle Eastern perspective. Dr. Bailey uses the Aramaic translation of the words found in the Gospel of Matthew as a means to gather insights into the deeper and truer meaning that Jesus was teaching His Disciples as well as us. When we pray this well-known prayer, we are asking that God's name be hallowed, recognizing that God is the Person that is making it holy, not us. He is a very active participant as we say this prayer.

When we pray the Lord's Prayer, we are calling out to touch the heart of God at the deepest level with the awareness that His love for imperfect people and His holiness come together. The Lord's Prayer is a summary of the theology of God. A one-hour session will be held on Monday the 13th at 2pm in Founders' Hall. Newcomers are always welcome.
