Planning Ahead

Ken Bailey Video Series—September 8th

Dr. Kenneth Bailey starts a new four-part video series on "The Lord's Prayer." He presents this study in the context of the culture and values of the Middle East by examining the Aramaic language in which Jesus spoke this prayer to His disciples. Bailey begins by explaining the Aramaic meaning behind the opening phrase, "Our Father," which in its most personal form is the equivalent of "Daddy," as a small child would say to his parent. With this, Jesus had brought a new vision of man's relationship with God, teaching the Disciples how to pray anew with those intimate and awesome words which we use today. The Lord's Prayer is corporate yet personal, simple yet awesome. Bailey continues with the next phrase, "who is in heaven" and speaks of the nearness of our God who is also far away in heaven. Yet there is no place at which God is nearer to us than when we come to know our Lord Jesus Christ. We are not standing before an awesome power that is also at great distance. A one-hour session will be held on Monday the 8th at 2pm in Founders' Hall. This would be an excellent time to visit; everyone is most welcome.
