We would like to let everyone know about the contents of the offering envelope boxes. In addition to the weekly white tithe envelope, each box contains:

- Initial Offering Envelope (yellow) is a contribution to the printing and processing of offering envelopes. It helps the church offset this cost. You can contribute any amount.
- Per Capita Apportionment (blue) is the amount of money per member of the church that we send to the Presbytery to use in their mission work. It is \$31 per person this year.
- Milestones (pink) is a donation to our endowment program. The endowment is a savings account for the church to assist in any major financial need in the future. It is our financial safety net. You may contribute any amount and it will go into our savings fund.
- Deacon's Fund (white and gold) is a monthly envelope that designates funds to the Deacons of the church to use in their mission work here in PB and San Diego. You may donate any amount.

Don't forget to pick up your box of pledge envelopes now in the church office. Boxes are alphabetically listed. If you would like a box and don't find yours, please leave your name in the office, I'll be glad to get you one. By picking up your box, you are saving the church postage fees. Those with Vanco accounts have offering numbers, but may not have boxes. *Clio McEuen*
