Adult Education

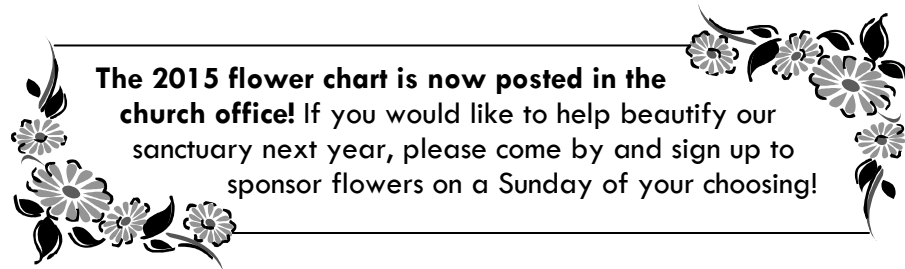
