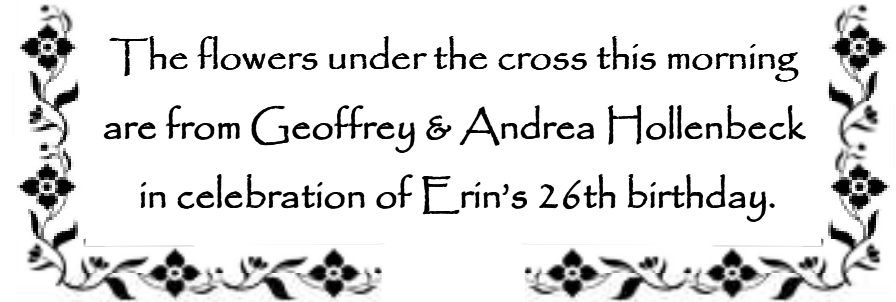
Announcements

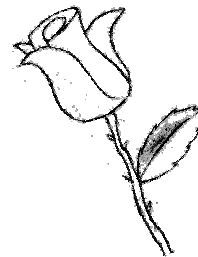
ADULT EDUCATION
