### Ken Bailey Video Class August 5 and 10

Dr. Bailey continues his series on Paul's first letter to the Corinthians, focusing on chapter 13, the "Love Chapter." He notes how the early church used this chapter as a focal point for their rapidly developing community of believers. Without love nothing in the Christian faith has any real intrinsic value. Paul uses the image of mountains to enhance our understanding of love. He suggests that we put aside the spiritual gifts and go for love much like climbing upward to a mountain pass. The way of love is exhilarating, exciting, dangerous, fraught with possibilities of falling, requiring great energy, and lots of commitment. But the view from the top will give you vision and will result in great fulfillment. Identical one-hour sessions will be held on Wednesday the 5th at 7:00pm and Monday the 10th at 2:00pm in Founders' Hall. Each session begins with a 30-minute DVD presentation followed by a discussion of Dr. Bailey's insights. You are most welcome to visit.
