Ken Bailey Video Class—April 1 and 13:

In this session, Dr. Bailey concludes his discussion of the second of five essays found in Paul's first letter to the Corinthians on the subject of the "Christian Theology of Sexuality" or how we live out our male/female relationships in harmony with our understanding of who God is. Paul points out that it is our spiritual body, which includes our sexuality, that is resurrected upon death. That is, sexuality involves the whole person and not just the flesh. The believer becomes one spirit with God, not one body. Otherwise, it would be impossible for there to be Christian marriage. In such marriage, there are positive rights which each partner freely offers to the other as gifts. Identical one-hour sessions will be held on Wednesday the 1st at 7pm and Monday the 13th at 2pm in Founders' Hall. You are invited to check out this enlightening series.
