It is our tradition here at PB Presbyterian to celebrate communion on the first Sunday of every month. We now offer gluten-free bread in addition to traditional bread.

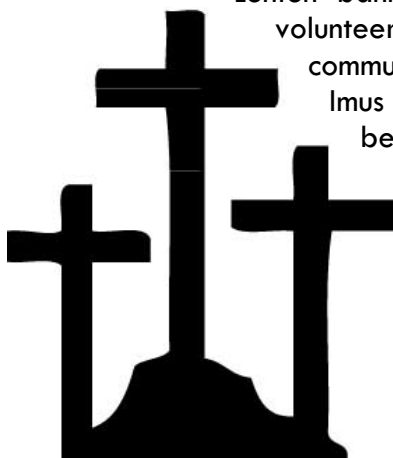
Special Thank You

Dr. Kenneth Bailey continues his series on "I Corinthians" by looking at the second of five essays that comprise the letter.
