#### Ken Bailey Video Class-May 6 and 11

Dr. Bailey discusses the third essay, found chapters 8 through 10, of Paul's first letter to the Corinthians. The subject of this essay is "Christians in a Non-Christian World." The problem in Corinth and elsewhere was that new Christians were scared that they might offend the other gods that were being worshipped round them. Also, because food laws were a big deal to Jews, they didn't know how to treat the food that had been offered to those gods. Paul says that our strength as Christians does not depend on what we eat. However, if doing so causes our brother to stumble, we should avoid that food altogether. We are to live our lifestyle and witness to the world around us while not offending other people's faith. This is what Jesus did with those he encountered. Identical one-hour sessions will be held on Wednesday the 6th at 7:00 p.m. and Monday the 11th at 2:00 p.m. in Founders' Hall. Each session begins with a 30-minute DVD presentation followed by a discussion of Dr. Bailey's insights.
