Ken Bailey Video Class—November 9th

We begin a new series this month, this time on "The Beatitudes of Jesus." Dr. Bailey will begin with the first three of the nine beatitudes found in Matthew, chapter 5: "blessed are the poor in spirit," "blessed are those who mourn," and "blessed are the gentle (*meek*)."
Dr. Bailey draws upon his 40 years of teaching the New Testament in seminaries and research institutes in Egypt, Lebanon, Jerusalem, and Cyprus. Through his experiences he shares the subtle nuances of the languages and cultures, thereby enhancing the treasures found in the Scriptures. A one-hour session will be held on Monday the 9th at 2pm in Founders' Hall. The 30-minute DVD is followed by a discussion of the parables and Dr. Bailey's insights. This would be a great time to come and check out this way of understanding Biblical treasures.
