

## Planning Ahead

### Ken Bailey Video Class — This Tuesday, August 9

Dr. Ken Bailey concludes his presentation of "Understanding the Bible" by discussing "The Seven Sins of Bible Interpretation." These are the methods that various people have used over the centuries to interpret the Scriptures. They include the "allegorical method," the "cut and paste method," and the "colored glasses method." These and other "sins of Bible interpretation" remind us to try to discover what the original author intends for his readers. We will be rewarded with new understanding when we put ourselves in the original audience and the original cultural context. **The one-hour session will be held in Founders' Hall on Tuesday the 9th at 12:00 noon.** *Note that this is a change from the past schedule of twice each month.* The session begins with a 30-minute video followed by a discussion of Dr. Bailey's insights. First-timers are especially invited to come and enjoy the insights that Ken Bailey offers.
