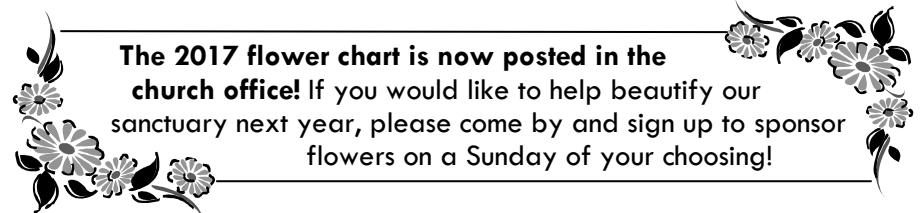


Adult Education
