#### Today We Welcome Rev. Michael Mudgett

Rev. Mudgett was originally ordained by San Diego Presbytery in 2007 after an extensive career in law where he served first in the Judge Advocate General's Corps (JAG) for five years and then transitioned into a career in civil law. He also has considerable experience in real estate investing. Rev. Mudgett is currently a member of Pacific Presbytery where he served as the Executive Pastor for Malibu Presbyterian Church for about six years. Six months after arriving at Malibu Presbyterian the structures burned to the ground so the church needed to shift into a rebuilding mode which he played a significant part in. He then assumed an Interim Pastor position at St. Mark's Presbyterian Church in Lomita, California. Rev. Mudgett is a graduate of Princeton Theological Seminary, Georgetown Law Center, University of San Diego Law School and Arizona State University. As part of his continuing education Rev. Mudgett participated in "Walking in the Footsteps of Paul Study Tour" in Greece and Turkey in 2012, Israel Pastors' Study Tour, Jerusalem University 2009 and Mission Trips to Haiti, Uganda, Amazon River and several Mexico home building missions. Rev. Mudgett is now the Interim Executive Presbyter of the Presbytery of San Diego.
