



Congratulations to our 2016 Graduates!

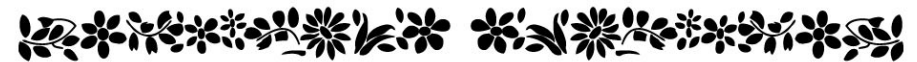
- **Jake Arambel**, Bob & Jan Miner's grandson, is graduating from high school and will be going to the University of Wisconsin in Milwaukee in the fall.

"Understanding the Bible"— July 6th and 11th

This month we are starting a new, two-part video series titled "Understanding the Bible." Dr. Kenneth Bailey begins with several ways of looking at the inspiration of the Scriptures and the development of the Old Testament from the first five books alone to which the Prophets and history were added, followed by the addition of the Writings. During the 2nd century, the writings of Paul and others were gradually included in the Bible until, by 367 AD, the full 27 books of the New Testament were pronounced authoritative. Then Dr. Bailey analyzes the first four verses of Luke to reveal the probable method by which the formation of the New Testament took place. Luke describes the events that took place among them, the eyewitness accounts by ministers of the Word, and the texts which many of them had written. He then put them into his Gospel in an orderly way. Identical one-hour sessions will be held on Wednesday the 6th at 7pm and Monday the 11th at 2pm in Founders' Hall.
