


Planning Ahead

Ken Bailey Video Class — November 8

Dr. Bailey continues his series on "A Clear View of Jesus' Birth" in this session, "Salvation and the Wise Men." He discusses how the concept of salvation was explained in Jesus from the prophet Isaiah through and beyond the Gospel writings. Bailey also discusses the impact and importance of the wise men who came from the east. They brought gold because they were rich, frankincense as a symbol of the pleasing aroma of a sacrifice, and myrrh as a precursor to the embalming of a dead person. Isaiah was dreaming about the city of the New Jerusalem. He dreamt of a great light, the glory of the Lord shining, the coming of Arabs on camels and bringing wealth, the coming of shepherds, and a tragic story about children who were killed. But that great vision never happened to the city. However, it is fulfilled in what happened about the child Jesus. A one-hour session, beginning with a 30-minute video, will be held in Founders' Hall on Tuesday the 8th at 12:00 noon. Everyone is welcome to come and enjoy the insights that Ken Bailey offers.
