Ken Bailey Video Class—October 11

Dr. Bailey continues his series on the events surrounding Jesus' birth by looking at the genealogy of Mary as well as the type of man that Joseph was. In the genealogy, five women are mentioned, some of outstanding character and others of questionable repute. This gives us some idea of the kind of people that the Messiah came to save. In the scripture, Joseph is called a "just man." This usually means a fair person, one who applies the rules equally. However, the text says that Joseph is a just man who, before God, put aside the Law of Moses which called for stoning Mary because of her pregnancy out of wedlock. According to the text, God's justice is compassion, tenderness, and concern for the weak, the downtrodden, the outcast, and those in need of help. Joseph's stature is clear, having in him great qualities of boldness, daring, courage, and strength of character. The one-hour session will be held in Founders' Hall on Tuesday the 11th at 12:00 noon. The session begins with a 30-minute video followed by a discussion of Dr. Bailey's insights. Everyone is welcome to come and enjoy the insights that Ken Bailey offers.
