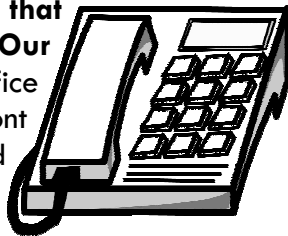


## Adult Education

### **Ken Bailey Video Class — September 13**
