


Adult Education

“Jesus and His Vision of Mission” — Tuesday, May 9th

This video series continues with a discussion of “Reaching Out To Those Around Us.” Dr. Ken Bailey discusses how the people of Israel saw themselves as a nation called by God, yet Jesus is calling individuals of all nations. He explains how, when we take the Gospel to people, we must be sensitive that we are taking only the Gospel and not the “clothing” of our own culture. The Gospel must not imitate our culture, but will take root in the receiver's culture. Dr. Bailey comments on Jesus' promise to be “with you always, even to the end of the age.” This statement immediately follows His command to “go and make disciples of all nations.” Thus our task of mission is never-ending. A one-hour session will be held on **Tuesday the 9th at 12:00 noon** in Founders' Hall. We begin with a 30-minute video presentation, followed by informal sharing of our own reactions to Dr. Bailey's presentation.
