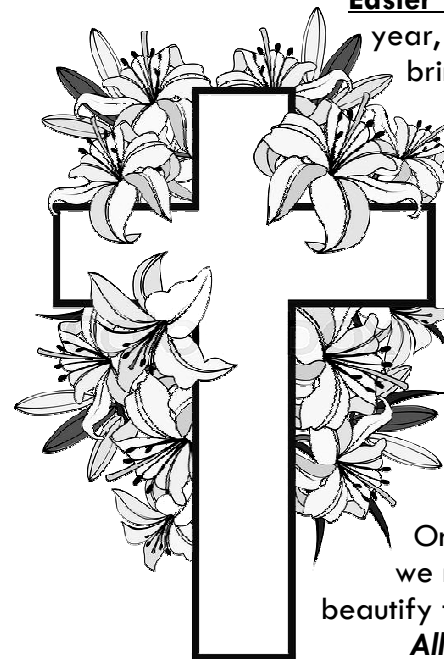

Planning Ahead

“Jesus and His Vision of Mission” — April 11th

Dr. Ken Bailey continues his video tape series with a discussion of “Contrasts & Themes of Christian Mission” as found in Matthew 28 where we find the Great Commission. We are reminded that a successful mission effort is not the first requirement, but rather a faithful effort is necessary. Even Jesus was not always successful, as in the case of Judas and of those who doubted Jesus’ words and authority. Dr. Bailey offers a diagram of “Six Levels of Christology,” information about the nature of the person of the eternal and earthly Christ. These include Jesus’ pre-existence, self-emptying, resurrection/ascension, enthronement, and His coming again. Following the Resurrection and before the Ascension, Jesus clearly redirects His salvation “to the ends of the earth”, no longer exclusively to Israel. As always, Dr. Bailey adds his own Middle East experiences to the texts, providing flavor to the Scriptures that will enrich your Christian walk. A one-hour session will be held on **Tuesday the 11th at 12:00 noon** in Founders' Hall. We begin with a 30-minute tape presentation, followed by informal sharing of our own reactions to Dr. Bailey’s presentation. Newcomers are always welcome.
