



Adult Education

"Jesus and His Vision of Mission" - July 11th

The Bailey video tape series continues this month with a discussion of "The Task and Ministry of Crossing Cultural Lines." Dr. Bailey focuses on three great people in the New Testament that speak to us today about "mission." They are the Apostle Paul, Apollos, and Mary the mother of Jesus. The mission of Paul was as one who would go to places where the message had not been heard. He very much wanted to be a pioneer. Apollos watered where Paul planted. The task of Apollos was that of becoming both a teacher and a student. He taught churches which Paul founded and they taught him. Mary stood at the Cross as a model of faith, courage, and discipleship for all of us. Imagine a mother watching her son tortured for six grueling hours while there was nothing that she could do about it. She chose not to walk away. A one-hour session will be held on Tuesday the 11th at 12 noon in Founders' Hall. Newcomers are always welcome.
