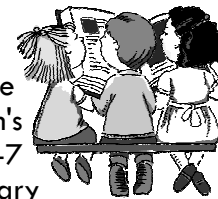

"Jesus and His Vision of Mission"

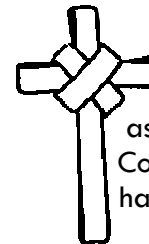
This Tuesday, March 14th at 12:00 noon

This month we continue the eight-part Bailey video series with a discussion of "Evangelism, Justice Advocacy, and Compassion in Mission." In Luke 4:18-19, Jesus presents His understanding of His ministry. It is like a dense diamond which describes what our own Christian walk should be like. Dr. Bailey discusses this and our participation in that ministry. Evangelism is a witness of God's attributes to those who sense that they are in need. Justice advocacy is the struggle for a better and more just society, seeking to meet the needs of others. And finally, compassion is the glue that binds evangelism and justice together. Both evangelism and justice advocacy must be carried out with compassion. Therefore evangelism, justice advocacy, and compassion are like a dense diamond which should be the foundation for our ministry to the world. **A one-hour session will be held on Tuesday the 14th at 12:00 noon in Founders' Hall.** Newcomers are always welcome.



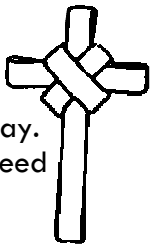
