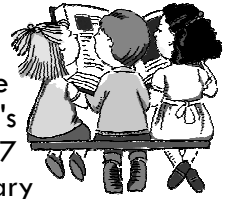
### **A Grateful THANK YOU and an Update on Pledge Status**

The Stewardship Team and Session would like to thank those donors who responded to the recent request for an additional pledge this year to assist in your Church having a balanced budget for 2017. At the beginning of 2017 we had received 63 pledges for a total of \$257,796 to meet our financial obligations. Following the recent request of the 63 original donors, we received 36 responses for an additional total pledge of **\$7,210**. 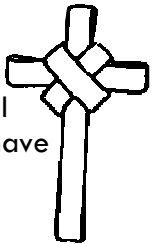
