**Banner Note: *The Declaration of Barmen*, one of our Presbyterian Confessions, was written in 1934 by theologian and pastor Dr. Karl Barth.** Barmen is a city in Germany. It is the place where the confessing church, made up of Reformed Churches wrote this declaration protesting Nazi tyranny and the effort by the state to take the role of God and control the church. It is a protest against Hitler and his National Church. Its central doctrines are the sin of idolatry and the Lordship of Jesus Christ. The swastika is crossed out and the cross of Christ is rising. The fire represents the suffering and death of those defending the true faith. The cross survives such persecution, as it rises out of the flames.

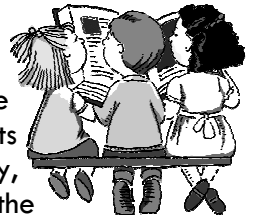

**Sunday Morning Bible Study, every 2nd & 4th Sundays of the month (next on 10/22) at 9am!**

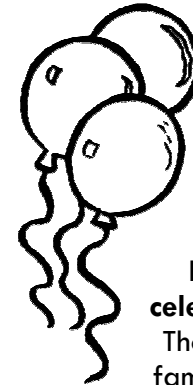

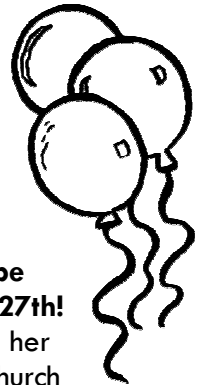
