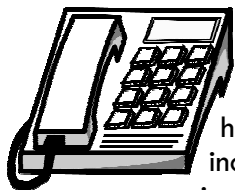


## Announcements

## Planning Ahead

### Ken Bailey Video Series — October 10th

Dr. Ken Bailey moves on in I Corinthians 13 to explore the definition of Christian love as found in this chapter. The Apostle Paul points out that love is in opposition to many human qualities: jealousy, boastfulness, arrogance, rudeness, quick anger, calculation of evil, and more. Love is patient, kind, unfeeling, covering all, believing all, hoping all, and enduring all. Dr. Bailey discusses both these positive and negative attributes and how they weave together to define God's love.

Paul concludes this chapter saying that, while the spiritual gifts of faith, hope, and love abide, love is the highest of them all. God's primary gift to us is love, not faith. It is the highest of all the spiritual gifts and is the characteristic mark of the Christian. So Dr. Bailey asks the question, "If love is higher than faith, then shouldn't we Christians be called Lovers instead of Believers?"

The one-hour session will be held on Tuesday the 10th at 12:00 noon in Founders' Hall. This 30-minute DVD will help us to see this great gift of God more clearly. Visitors are always welcome.
