### Ken Bailey Video Series—This Tuesday, April 10th

Dr. Bailey continues his discussion of the familiar parable that we often call "The Prodigal Son" by turning to the older son's response when his younger brother returned to their father. This session is titled "The Lost Older Son" because of that son's anger in the face of the grace shown by his father. He refused to join in the celebration, thereby breaking his relationship with the father as well as with his brother. Both brothers needed the same reconciliation that Jesus offers to us: the free gift of God's love. Jesus was redefining repentance as the acceptance of being found by the Father. The younger son accepted, but the older son did not. This 30-minute DVD, followed by discussion, will be held on Tuesday the 10th at 12:00 noon in Founders' Hall. Newcomers are especially invited to join us.
