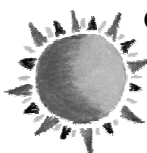


Adult Education

The parables of "The Sower" and "The Two Builders" are featured by Dr. Bailey this month. These parables are studied as by one who stands at the rear of Jesus' audience and lets His words come through the listeners to us. "The Sower" demonstrates that there is no instant or guaranteed discipleship through the slow growth in the Lord and discipleship to Him. It is a lifelong occupation. The "Builders" parable, based on an Isaiah passage, tells of a new foundation that is laid on the Word of the Father which Jesus brings to the community.
