Ken Bailey Video Series — February 13th

This month "The Parables of Jesus in Luke" focuses on The Lost Sheep and The Lost Coin, in which Jesus redefines the concept of repentance. He says that repentance is not something that we do or achieve, it is the acceptance of God's offer of costly love in Jesus. Jesus blames the Pharisees for losing the sheep and likens Himself to the Good Shepherd who goes after that sheep. The Parable of The Lost Coin has a similar theme but is somewhat more intense and is directed toward the experiences of women. Again something is lost and great effort is put forth in recovering it. In both cases, when the lost is found there is great rejoicing in the community which represent the believers. This 30-minute DVD, followed by discussion, will be held on Tuesday the 13th at 12:00 noon in Founders' Hall. Newcomers are especially invited to join us. Come and enjoy a fresh look at these parables.

We would like to let everyone know about the contents of the offering envelope boxes. In addition to the weekly white tithe envelope, each box contains:
