We would like to let everyone know about the contents of the offering envelope boxes. In addition to the weekly white tithe envelope, each box contains:

- Initial Offering Envelope (yellow) is a contribution to the printing and processing of offering envelopes. It helps the church offset this cost. You can contribute any amount.
- Per Capita Apportionment (blue) is the amount of money per member of the church that we send to the Presbytery to use in their mission work. **Per Capita is \$34.94 per person for 2018.**
- Milestones (pink) is a donation to our endowment program. The endowment is an investment account for the church to assist in our financial needs. You may contribute any amount and it will go into our investment portfolio. This portfolio is professionally managed and the amounts invested remain secure.
- Deacons' Fund (white and gold) is a monthly envelope that designates funds to the Deacons of the church to use in their mission work here in PB and San Diego. You may donate any amount.
- Vanco— We have a way for you to make your donation to PBPC online. Please visit our website www.pbpres.org and click on the Donate button to get started.

Pledge Envelopes: Boxes of pledge envelopes, for anyone who made a pledge or normally donates to our church, are available in the church office (on a table, in alphabetical order). If you want them and do not find a box with your name, please leave a note on the clipboard on the table, and they'll be available to pick up the following Sunday.
