There will be a white basket for your donations in the Narthex on Sundays throughout the months of July & August, and in the church office during the week.

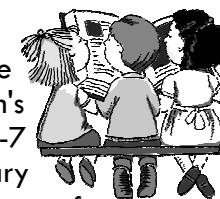
