

Ken Bailey Video Series — March 13th

This month Dr. Ken Bailey turns to the first part of the parable which we call "The Prodigal Son" and analyzes its many details as powerful examples of Jesus' new definition of repentance as not something that we do or achieve, but as the acceptance of being found by God. The youngest son asks for his inheritance while the father was still living. In the face of this great insult, the gracious father agrees, the son converts the inheritance into cash, moves to a Gentile country, and wastes it on expensive living. Now destitute, the son gets the only job available, that of feeding pigs - an unclean occupation for a Jew. After swallowing his pride, he returns to the village where his father runs to meet him in a humiliating act for a stately Jewish man. This was a very costly demonstration of unexpected love, just as Jesus did for us on the cross. The son accepts to be found by the father. This is repentance. This 30-minute DVD, followed by discussion, will be held on Tuesday the 13th at 12:00 noon in Founders' Hall. Newcomers are especially invited to join us. Come and enjoy a fresh look at this sometimes too familiar parable.
