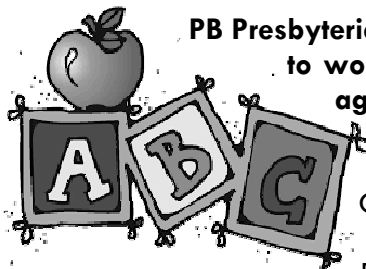


## Announcements
