Planning Ahead

Ken Bailey Video Series—May 8th

This month Dr. Bailey turns to the parable of "The Woman in the House of Simon" where an immoral woman shows her gratitude to Jesus, the agent of God's love, by washing His feet with her tears, drying them with her hair, and anointing them with perfume. She was responding to the love she had received from Jesus earlier. Simon, who had not shown Jesus the traditional courtesies of a guest by washing His feet and giving Him a greeting kiss, had brought Jesus into his home to "put Him under the magnifying glass." The woman was compensating for Simon's mistakes. Jesus then told a parable about the depth of forgiveness which incriminated Simon's dependence on good works. Jesus then told the woman, "Your faith has saved you, go in peace." Simon's response was only resentment. A 30-minute DVD, followed by discussion, will be held on Tuesday the 8th at 12:00 noon in Founders' Hall.
