Ken Bailey Video Series—This Tuesday, September 11th

This month Dr. Bailey shares his insights on two stories which are not often thought of as parables: "Zacchaeus" and "A King in a Far Country." Zacchaeus is the man who, when he climbed a tree in order to see Jesus as He passed by, was asked by Jesus to share a meal with Him and thus begin his discipleship. Zacchaeus allowed himself to be found, which was his repentance, and he was granted the new status of righteousness. The second story is about the nobleman who gave each of his servants some money to use while he was gone. Two of them invested their money and made considerable profits. A third servant hid his money and didn't earn a cent. This parable portrays Jesus who will return as King to see what we have done with the gifts that He has given us to use. It is through our faithfulness in using those gifts that we discover God as the source of love and compassion. Join us for this 30-minute DVD followed by discussion.
